Explore one of Kenya's newest and most successful rhino sanctuaries, where all retained earnings directly contribute to Borana Conservancy's conservation efforts.



Borana Conservancy lies at the foot of Mt Kenya at 6,500 feet. This 32,000 acre private conservancy is perfectly situated for wildlife, and home to some of the most fantastic vistas Kenya has to offer.

You will spend three nights at Borana Lodge, exploring this breathtaking landscape from the heart of the conservancy either on foot, by horseback, by bicycle or in a vehicle.

During your stay you will tour the Kabati Regenerative Farm which, in partnership with the Well Hung Butcher, provides Borana Lodge with free range, grass fed, organic beef and lamb as well as organic fruit, vegetables, milk, cream and eggs. The entire conservancy is on route to becoming 100% self-sustainable.

You will have the opportunity to take part in “behind the scenes of conservation” activities and truly get a feel of how some of the world's most endangered species are kept safe. This includes tracking rhino on foot with Borana's scouts and helping with deployments of the armed the anti-poaching team.
