Luxury tented lodge

Located in a remote and untouched part of the Kariega wilderness, Settlers Drift offers a unique tented safari combined with 5-star luxury. Gazing down from the deck overlooking the Bushman's river drift, it feels as if time has stood still since the last feet to have touched this remote valley were those of the 1820 Settlers as they guided their wagons across the river. The lodge consists of 9 spacious tented suites, each with stunning views and secluded viewing decks. The luxuriously appointed and perfectly positioned tented lodge delivers the ultimate guest experience.

LOCATION:

Situated in the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa, at the end of South Africa's famous Garden Route. The Reserve incorporates the Kariega and Bushmans Rivers. Settlers Drift is 110km from Port Elizabeth. (A short flight from Cape Town.)

DIRECTIONS:

By air:

Port Elizabeth airport is only 80 minutes drive from Settlers Drift.

By road from Port Elizabeth:

Travel along the N2 from Port Elizabeth towards Grahamstown and take the R72 turn-off towards Port Alfred via Alexandria. The turnoff to Settlers Drift is signposted and is 10km beyond Alexandria.

Boat transfer:

A boat transfer to Settlers Drift departs daily from the jetty at 13h30 (weather dependant) - therefore for guests to be able to enjoy this transfer, they must arrive at the gate by approx. 13h00.

LODGE & TENTED SUITES:

Accommodation is offered in 9 spacious luxury tented suites (each 110m²) with an opulent bedroom and living area, air-conditioning, wood burning stove, full bathroom, indoor/outdoor shower, mini-bar, private viewing deck. Lodge facilities include a restaurant, bar, lounges, library/lounge with satellite TV, wine cellar, spacious decks, curio shop, pool, boma and spa treatments.

GAME ACTIVITIES:

Kariega is unique in it's offering of a diversity of activities which include:

- Morning and late afternoon/evening game drives in open vehicles with experienced game rangers
- River cruises and walking safaris
- Fishing and canoeing

This malaria-free "Big-5" family owned and operated private Game Reserve comprises 10000 hectares of pristine wilderness that spans across 5 different eco-systems (riverine forest, valley bushveld, savannah grasslands, fynbos and acacia woodlands).

The reserve is home to more than 25 species of game including Lion, Elephant, Leopard, Buffalo, Rhino, Hippo, Hyena, Giraffe, Zebra, Wildebeest, Waterbuck, Nyala, Kudu, Warthog and a variety of other Antelope and more than 280 species of birds amongst which are high soaring Martial, Crowned and Fish Eagles which nest on the Reserve. Kariega prides itself in the abundance of general game and birdlife supplementing the "Big-5", with accommodation offered in 5 separate luxury lodges.
