Sapi Star Beds

There are very few places in the world NEW to photographic tourism and the 118,000ha Sapi Private Reserve is just that. It is here that Great Plains Conservation has opened a 6-night circuit of three small, authentic bush-camps, set 20kms apart, called the **Greater Mana Expedition**.

Guests spend two nights at each camp, each with just three accommodation units. From the first we explore neighbouring Mana Pools National Park and western sector of Sapi and its Zambezi floodplains. The second is far inland amongst Sapi's thick forest. Here guests sleep on star-beds and the focus is on walking along dry river beds and relaxation among the canopy of the ebony and mahogany trees. The final camp returns back to the Zambezi River where activities centre on boating, canoeing and fishing.

To start this fam trip we include 1 night at Great Plains Conservation's new **Mpala Jena Camp**. Located 18kms upstream from Victoria Falls in the Zambezi National Park, it is one of the very finest camps in Zimbabwe.
